RULES & REGULATIONS

Set-up: 9:00-11:00 am

Take-down: 3:00 pm

Set up

- All participating Art in Pinkney Park artists and crafters are responsible for their own set-up and take-down.
- **Participants who have used the display racks must return them to the back of the barn.**
- Please check your display area and make sure that you leave the Park as you found it. Garbage and recycling bins are provided. **Rowayton recycles paper, cardboard, glass, metal and plastic items.**

Parking

- Absolutely NO parking on the grass while unloading/loading. Please park your vehicle on the driveway. All cars should park on the same side while unloading/loading. If there is more than one car already in the driveway, please park on the same side as that vehicle. If cars are parked on both sides of the driveway, other vehicles are blocked.
- When you have finished unloading, please immediately remove your vehicle from the Park. Park in any legal parking area in Rowayton ... but **DO NOT PARK on Pennoyer Street outside the United Methodist Church**, which has Sunday workshop services -- Pennoyer Street needs to be available for parking for the congregation.

Tables, Chairs, Display Equipment

- Participants must provide their own chairs, tables and/or other display equipment.
- RAC owns eight (8) 6 x 8-foot display racks, which must be requested on the application form. A tag will be attached to each rack with the name of the artist who has reserved it. *Those who haven't reserved a rack are not entitled to use one.*

Staffing

- Participants are responsible for staffing their displays throughout the event.

CT Sales Tax

- Each participant is responsible for collecting the 6.35% CT Sales Tax.
